

Castle Hill School Parents' Evening October 2019

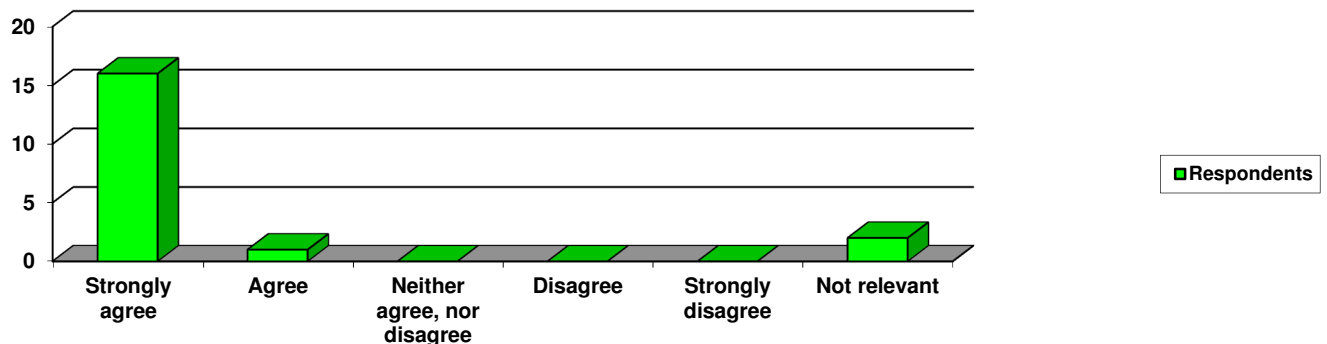
Attendance:

- **70% of parents/carers spoke to teacher face to face, either at Parents' Evening, a meeting at another time that week, or through regular visits to school (86/122 pupils)**
- **13% of parents/carers spoke to teacher via phone call, or during home visit (16/122 pupils)**
- **8% of parents/carers attended a recent EHCP review, or another formal meeting (10/122 pupils)**
- **2% of parents/carers have regular contact through Sally – FLOSO (2/122 pupils)**
- **7% of parents/carers keep in touch via home-school diary, but have not met to discuss progress with teachers as yet (8/122 pupils)**

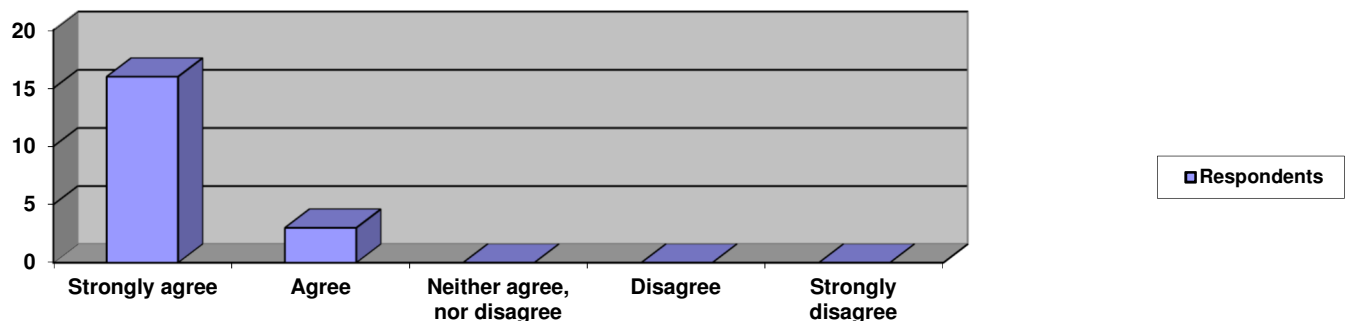

Results of Questionnaire following Parents' Evening (19 Respondents):

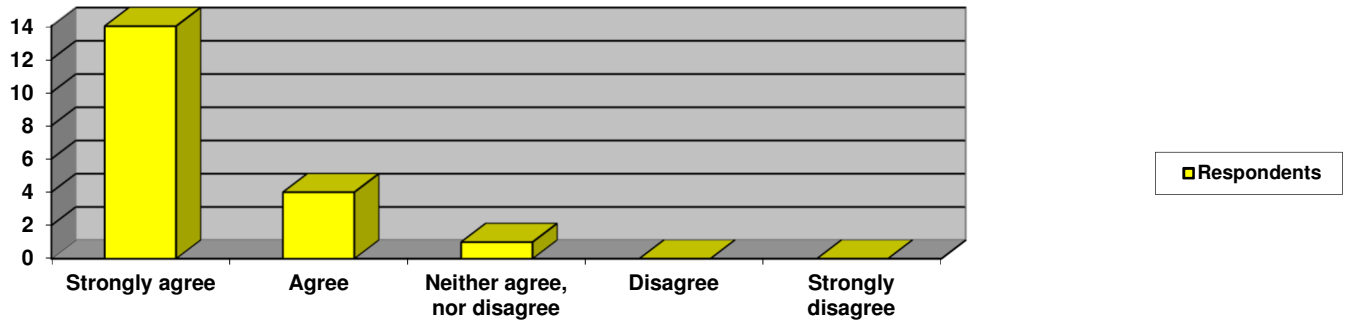
1. I am happy with the transition arrangements that were made for my child last term.



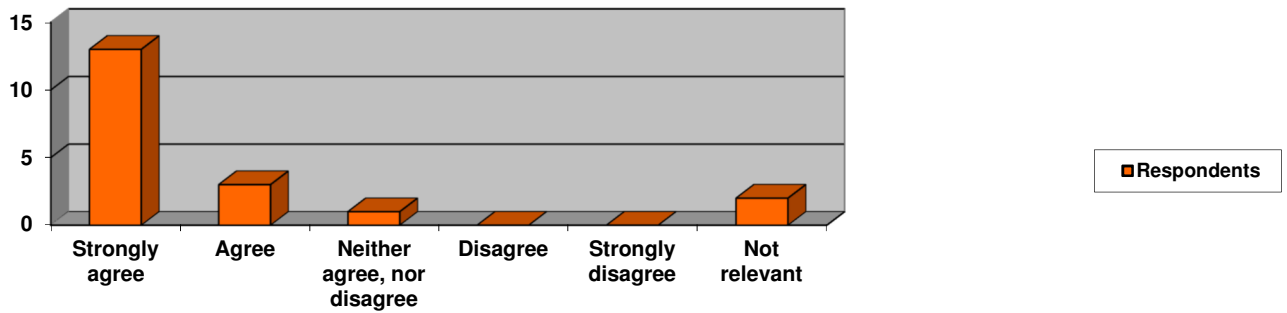
2. I am happy with the progress my child has made so far this year.



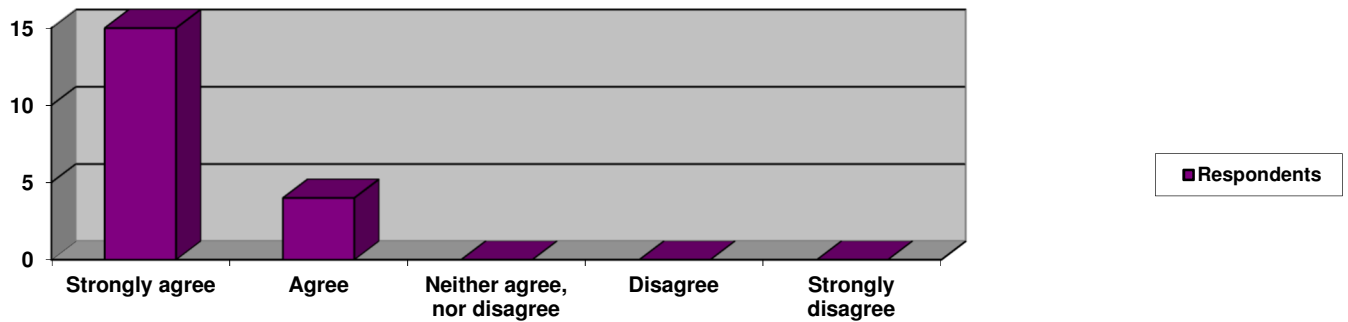
3. 'Next steps' for my child have been made clear.



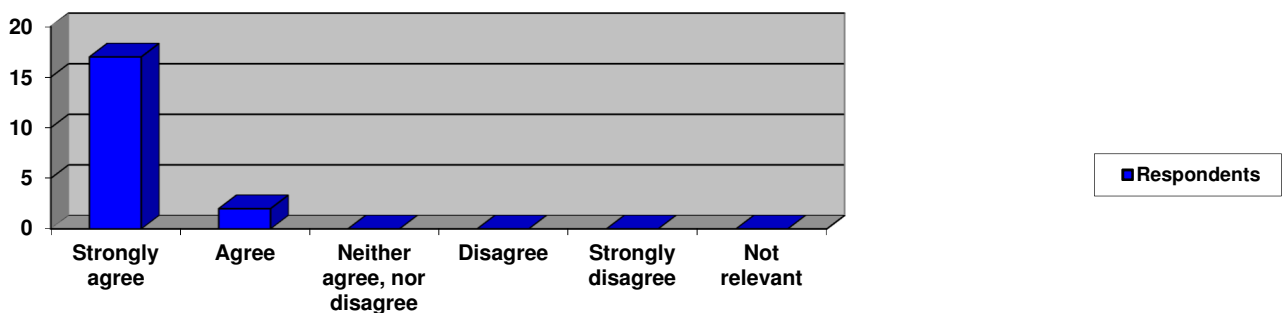
4. Any concerns or issues I have raised so far have been acted upon.

ACTIONS FOLLOWING PARENTS’ EVENING OCTOBER 2019

- i) Parental engagement remains high, with 93% of parents/carers attending Parents’ Evening, a recent EHCP review, or have spoken directly to teacher or FLOSO) at alternative time. Teachers remain committed to extending contact with remaining parents and carers further.
