

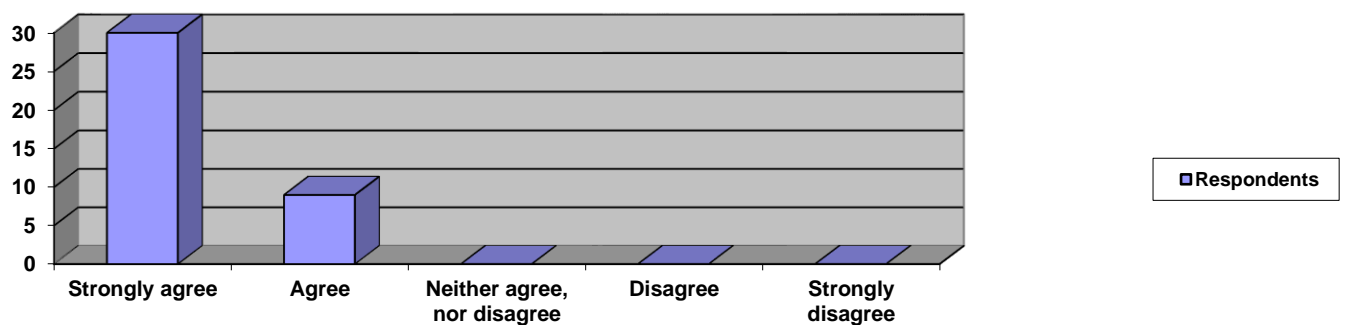
Attendance:

- **54% of parents/carers attended on the evening (65/122 pupils)**
- **17% of parents/carers spoke to teacher via phone call, when collecting child from school, or during home visit (21/122 pupils)**
- **22% of parents/carers attended a recent EHCP review, or another formal meeting (27/122 pupils)**

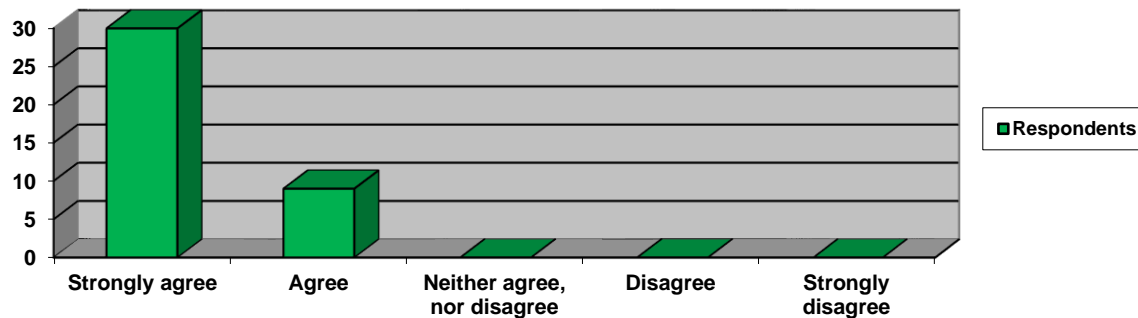

Results of Questionnaire following Parents' Evening (39 Respondents):

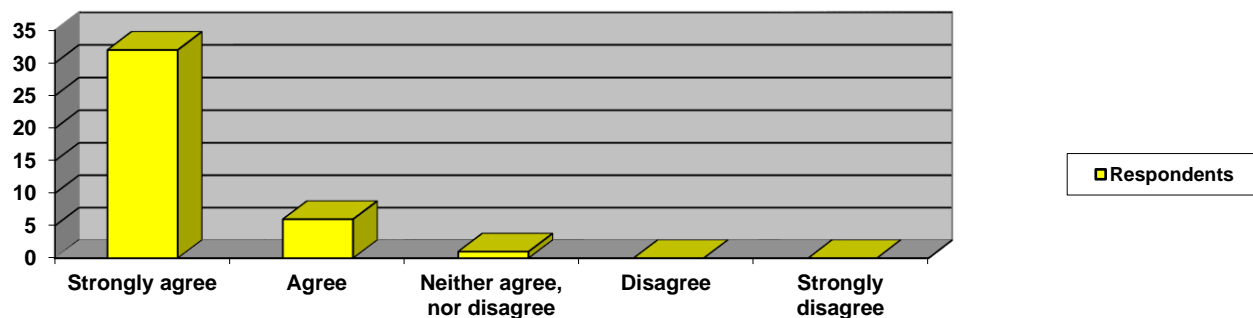
1. I am happy with the progress my child has made this year.



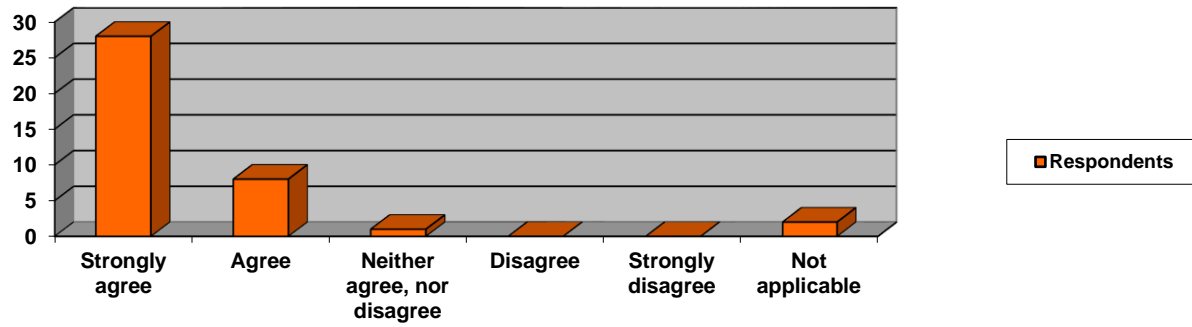
2. My child's school report (Learning Journal) has given me the information that I need.



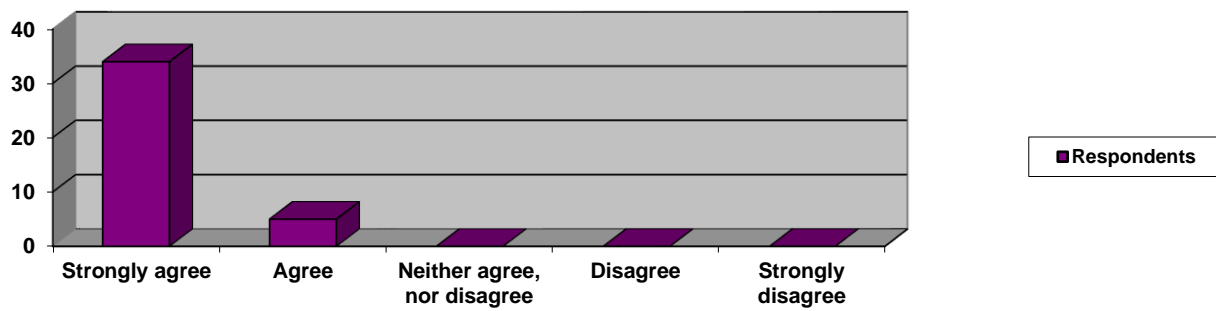
3. 'Next steps' for my child have been made clear.



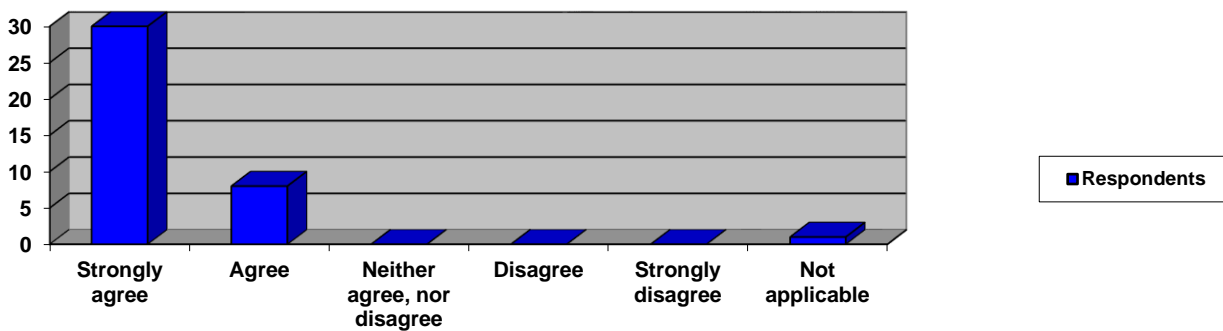
4. Any concerns or issues I have raised have been acted upon.



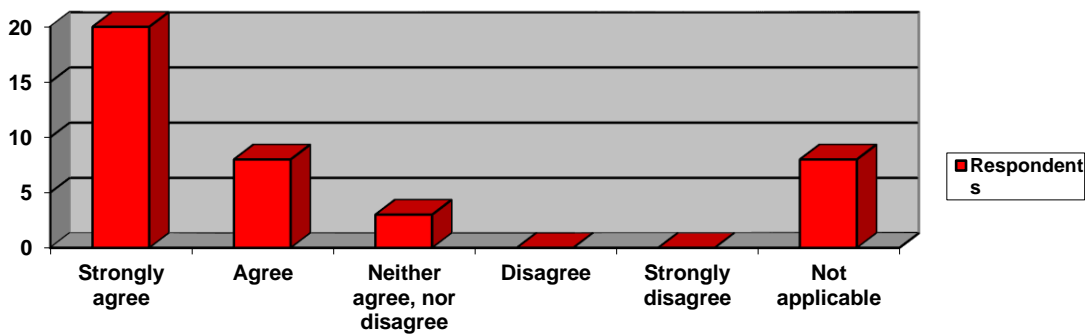
5. I have been happy with communication between home and school.

## OUTCOMES FOLLOWING PARENTS' EVENING JUNE 2019

- Parental engagement remains high. Almost 93% of parents/carers either attended Parents' Evening, spoke to teacher via phone call, when collecting child from school, or during home visit, or attended a recent EHCP review, or another formal meeting.
- Only 7% of parents/carers (9 pupils), have not engaged in the process this term. Class teachers will continue to make all efforts to speak with these parents/carers, to discuss their child's progress.
- There was a significant increase in parents/carers who strongly agreed that 'next steps' were made clear (22 to 32 respondents)
- There was an increase in parents/carers who strongly agreed that any concerns or issues that they had, were acted upon (22 to 28 respondents)

## ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN BEFORE NEXT PARENTS' EVENING

- Invite representatives from Post-19 settings to next Parents' Evening in October 2019, eg Waves, Kirklees College, Active, Connect, in order to provide information for parents and carers as appropriate.
