


Monthly Attendance Report 2017-2018 April/May




Exclusion of health/medial related absence refers to those pupils who are off school for significant periods of time due to reasons relating to their condition. Medical appointments and general health absences are included.

Outcomes:


The red line indicates the 2015-16 national DfE statistic data for attendance in Kirklees Special Schools (90.2%).

The whole school data continues to be in line with expectations when pupils with long term medical needs have been taken into account. The Family Liaison Support officer continues to track absences and keeps in regular contact with families who's children are absent from school.




Outcomes:

Where there is a significant reduction in attendance monitoring has been put into place. This includes weekly discussions between the Principal and FLOSO. Home visits and phone calls home are made on a regular basis to support integrating the pupils back into school.



Outcomes:

Primary 1&2 have improved in their attendance this month. Primary 6 has a drop in attendance, this is due to a pupil suffering an injury out of school and is expected to be a short term dip. Sixth form has also seen a drop in attendance. These areas will continue to be monitored.



Outcomes:

Secondary 2 has seen a significant drop in attendance this month. This will be followed up and discussed through the supervision meetings.
