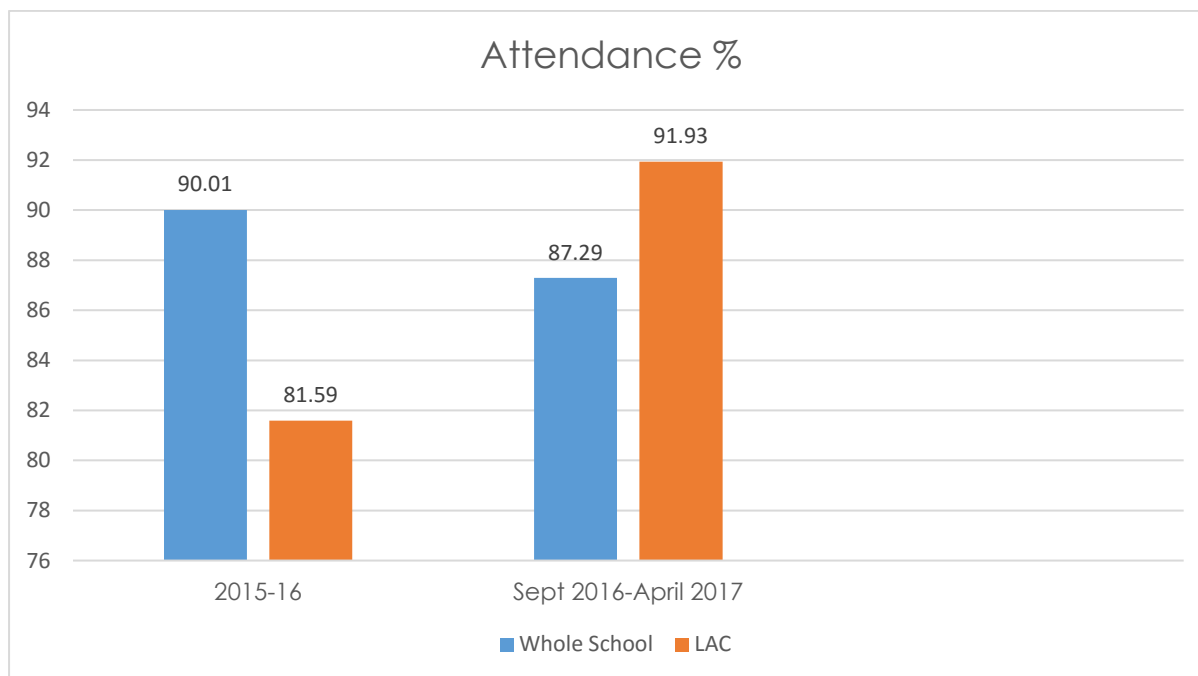

### Previously Reported Data.

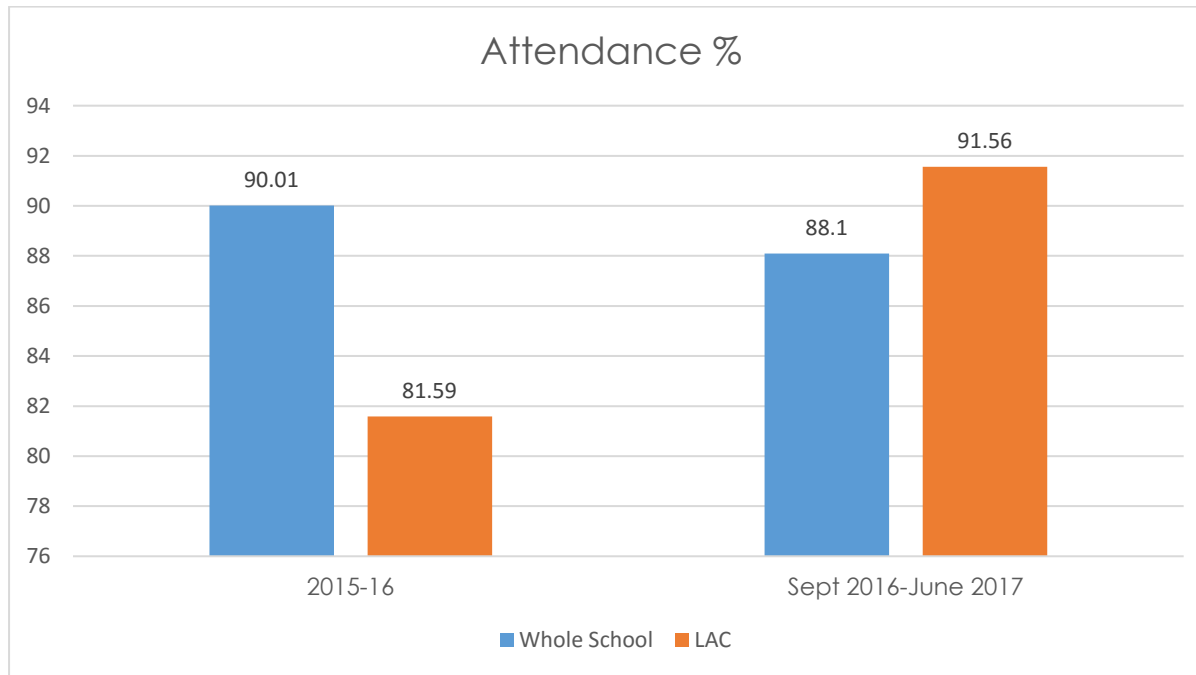
Please note that variations in % can occur when data is obtained on different dates. For Example the data collected for the LAC comparison dated Sept 17- Dec 17 was taken early December whereas the data for the whole school comparison Sept 17 – Dec 17 has been taken for the whole term.

In order to provide a clearer more accurate comparison the data in future will be collected every 4 weeks.



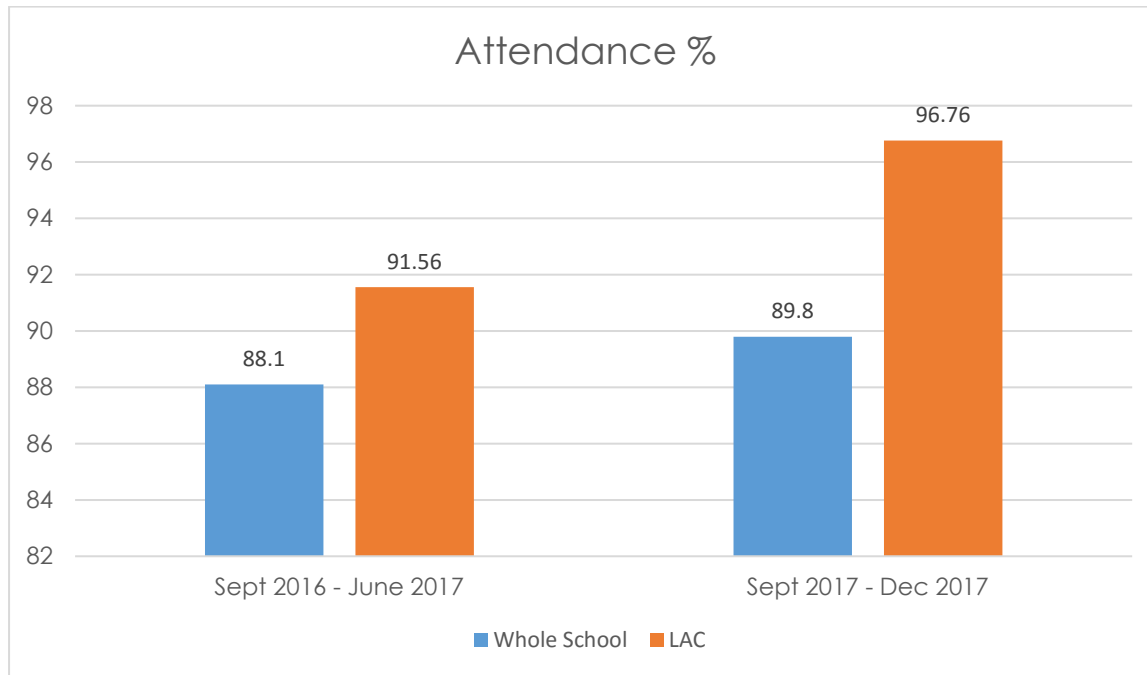
#### Outcomes:

Please note that the whole school attendance includes 5 pupils who have significantly low attendance.



**Outcomes:**

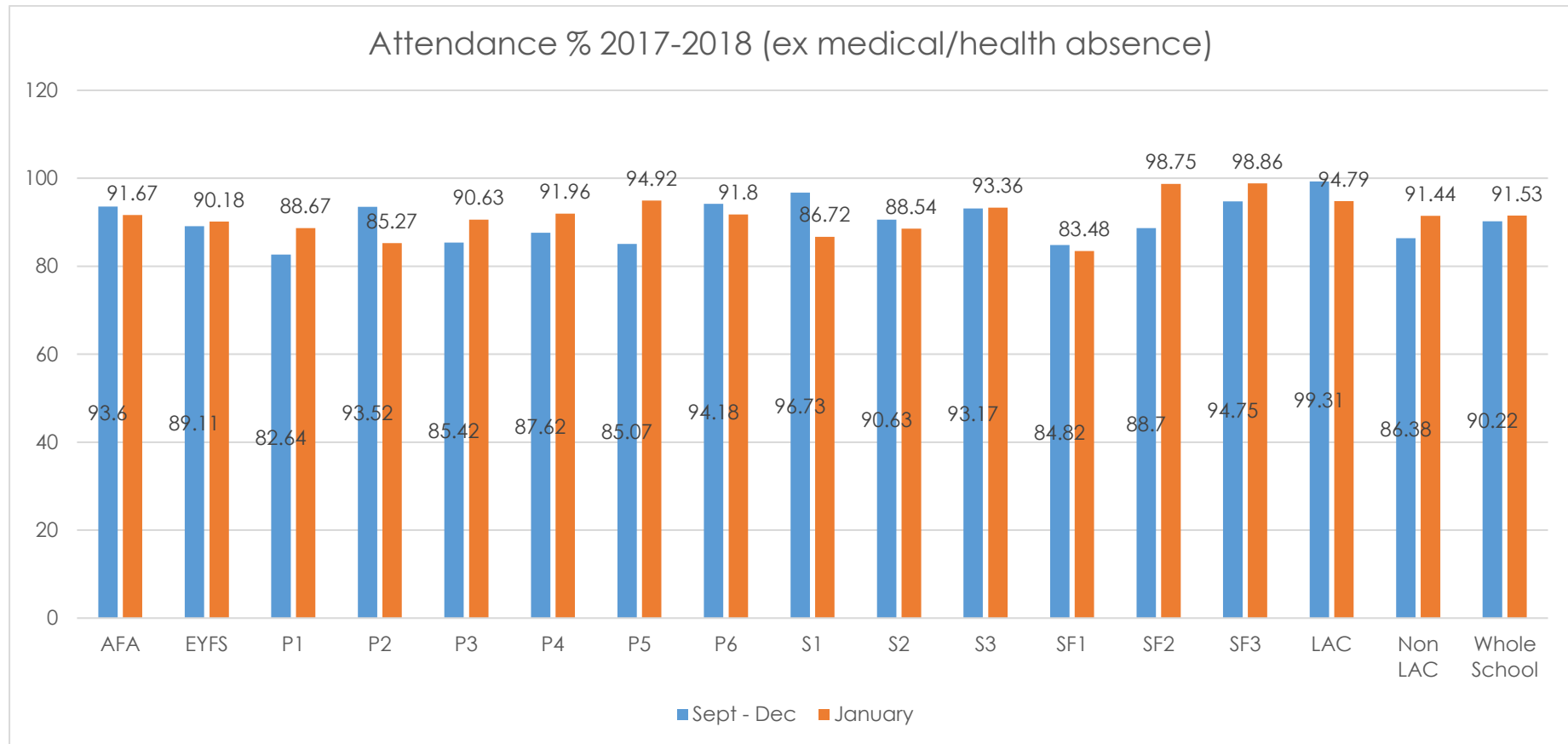
Please note that the whole school attendance includes 2 pupils who have moved out of authority but at present remain on our roll as they have not been allocated a new school place. 4 pupils have significantly low attendance.



**Outcomes:**

Pupils with significant health/ medical needs have been removed from the data.

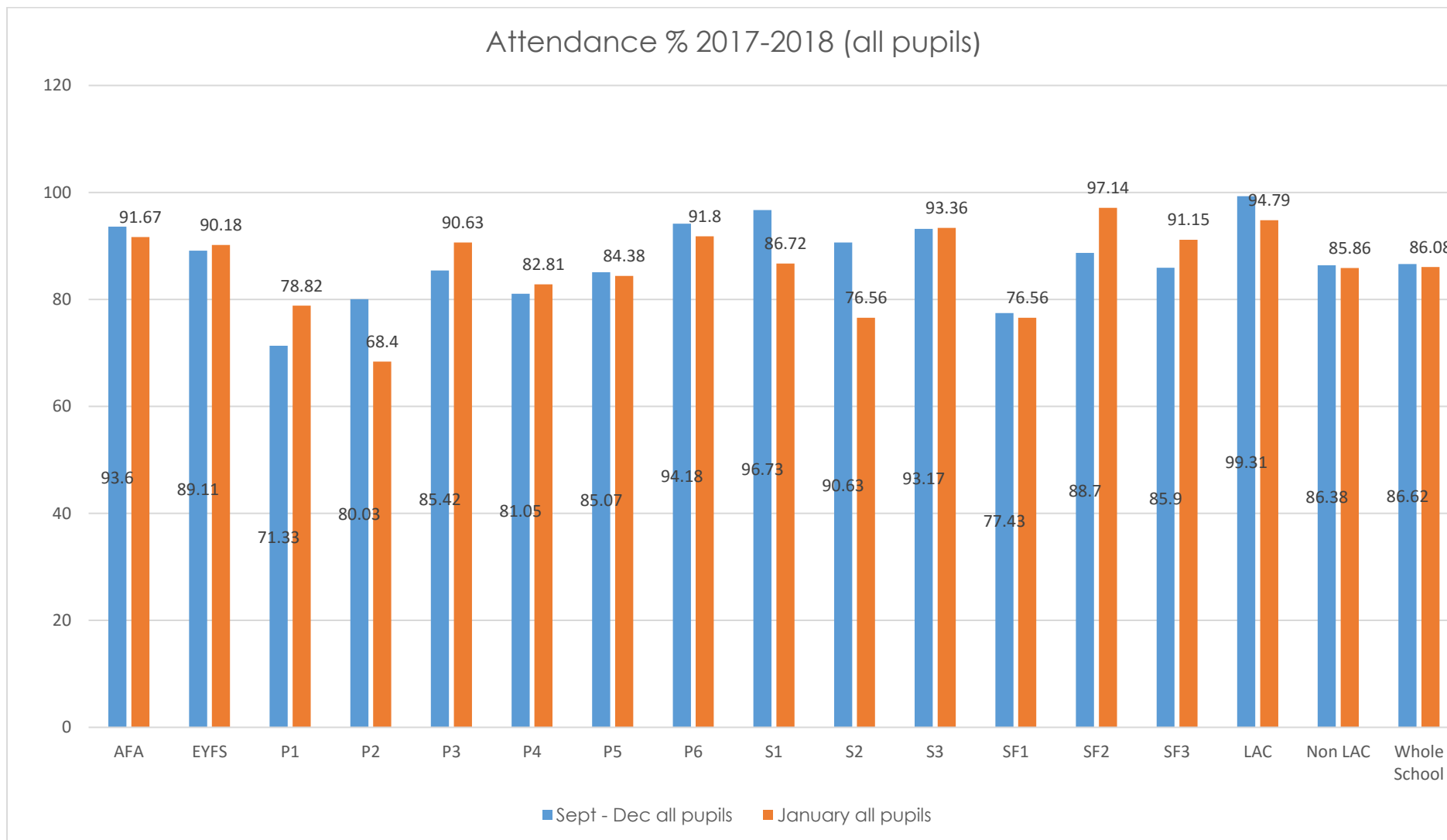
## Attendance breakdown and comparisons 2017-2018



### Outcomes:

Pupils who are currently off school due to long term health and medical reasons have been discounted from the data selection. These pupils are provided with work boxes for home and are in regular contact with the schools' FLOSO. The Principal and FLOSO meet on a regular basis to track individual attendance.

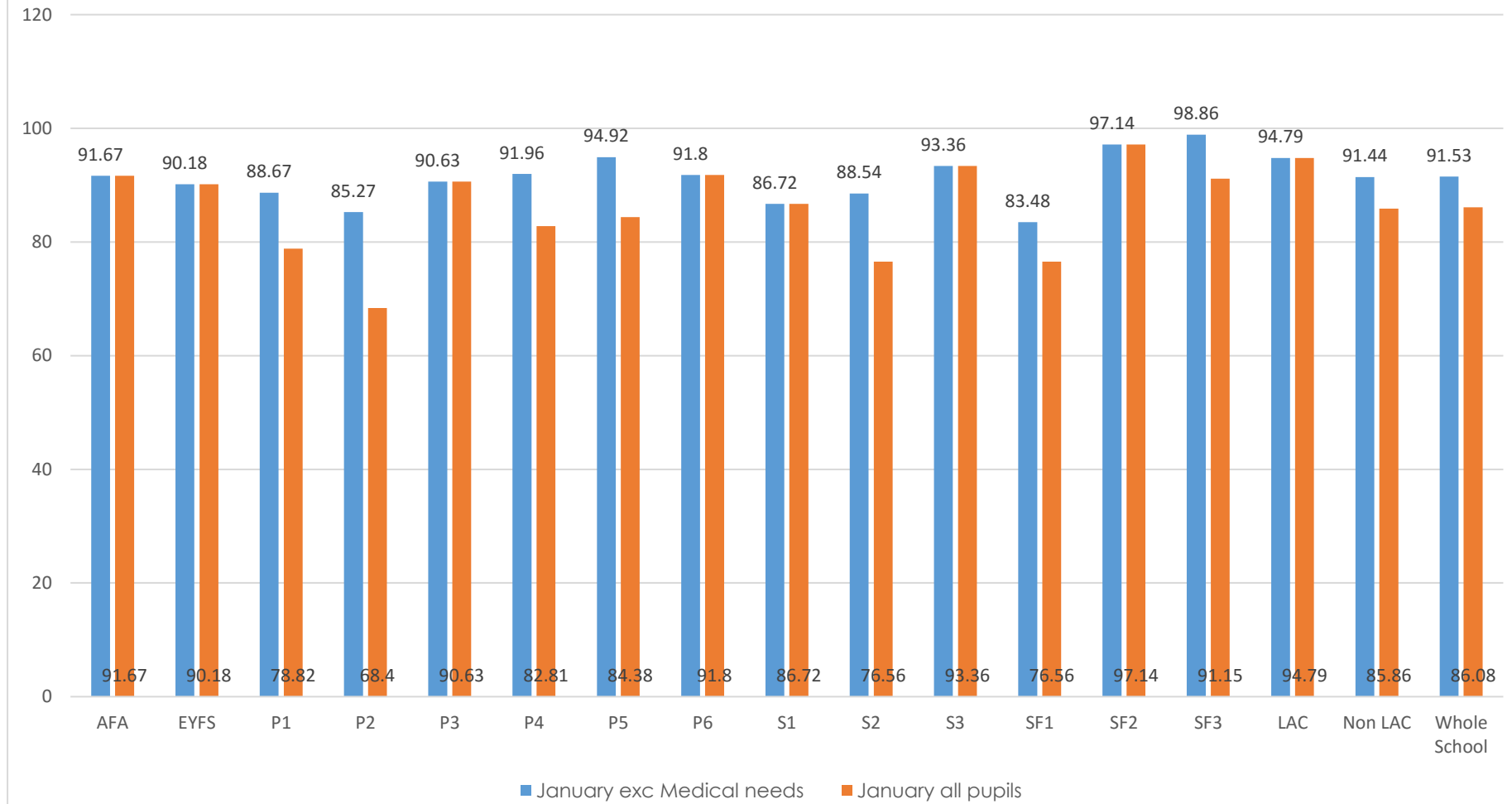
Attendance % 2017-2018 (all pupils)



Outcomes:

In order to make a true comparison of data the above graph shows the data for all pupils including those with significantly lower attendance due to medical/health needs.

## Attendance % January 2018



### Outcomes:

Every 4 weeks the attendance data will be analysed to identify patterns or concerns.

The January data shows that the more able groups have better attendance. For the more profound needs groups the older pupils have slightly better attendance than the younger pupils.
